NOTES:

1. Single accommodation cannot be guaranteed at busy times – please liaise with Manager in advance for details and options.
2. Day visitors should pay in cash. For other visitors an invoice will be raised and payment generally made by bank transfer or local cheque.
3. Food:
 - Visitors should bring their own supply of fresh food.
 - Tinned and dry/long-life provisions can be bought from the New Island store. Long-stay visitors can notify the Manager of any reasonable needs in advance, but supply cannot be guaranteed due to the vagaries of ship schedules etc.
 - If own stock of frozen food is being shipped to New Island please arrange for freezer space in advance with the Manager.
4. No visitors may use the NICT accounts with stores or suppliers on Stanley.
5. Visitors are asked to leave their accommodation in the same condition as they found it on arrival. The Trust reserves the right to charge a cleaning fee if necessary after vacation of the accommodation.
6. These rates assume landing by sea or helicopter in the Settlement. When the distant airstrip is recommissioned the rates will be adjusted to include a reasonable transportation cost.
