- 1. Single accommodation cannot be guaranteed at busy times please liaise with Wardens in advance for details and options.
- 2. Day visitors should pay in cash. For other visitors an invoice will be raised and payment generally made by bank transfer or local cheque.
- 3. Food:
 - Visitors should bring their own supplies of alcohol and fresh vegetables.
 - Tinned and dry/long-life provisions can be bought from the New Island store. Long-stay visitors can notify
 the Wardens of any reasonable needs in advance, but supply cannot be guaranteed.
 - If own stock of frozen food is being shipped to New Island please arrange for freezer space in advance with the Manager.
- 4. Visitors may NOT use the NICT accounts with stores or suppliers on Stanley.
- 5. Visitors are asked to leave their accommodation in the same condition as they found it on arrival. The Trust reserves the right to charge a cleaning fee if necessary after vacation of the accommodation.
