

NEW ISLAND CONSERVATION TRUST

DAY VISITORS AND HOLIDAY VISITOR CHARGES

Landing fee for each cruise ship passenger: £15.00 pp

Landing fee for each other day visitor per day: £15.00 pp

Holiday Visits – Self-Catering:

Includes for accommodation, cooking/heating fuel, cleaning materials, support from NICT staff. £50.00 pp per day.

North End Hut:

A minimum 2-night stay, visitors must have concurrent settlement accommodation:  
an additional £15 pp per night  
Plus a one-off  
£80.00 transit and set up fee.

Note:

- New Island may not be suitable for very young children, as we cannot supply cots, highchairs etc.
- However, children under 5 are free.
- Children aged 5-10 will be charged at 50% of the adult rate.

Transport Charges

Vehicle and driver depending on availability and ground conditions: £20.00 per hour

Use of Internet and Telephone

Wi-Fi cards are available for purchase from NICT wardens.

**NOTES:**

1. Single accommodation cannot be guaranteed at busy times – please liaise with Wardens in advance for details and options, with usually a minimum of 3 nights' stay due to logistical difficulties.
2. Day visitors should pay in cash. For other visitors an invoice will be raised and payment generally made by bank transfer or local cheque.
3. Food:
  - Visitors should bring their own supplies of alcohol and fresh vegetables.
  - Tinned and dry/long-life provisions can be bought from the New Island store. Long-stay visitors can notify the Wardens of any reasonable needs in advance, but supply cannot be guaranteed.
  - If own stock of frozen food is being shipped to New Island please arrange for freezer space in advance with the Wardens.
4. Visitors may NOT use the NICT accounts with stores or suppliers on Stanley.
5. Visitors are asked to leave their accommodation in the same condition as they found it on arrival. The Trust reserves the right to charge a cleaning fee if necessary after vacation of the accommodation.
